Core hours 7am - 2pm, with additional hours up to 5pm, as needed and agreed in advance. Additional days as required for internal exams or exam preparation, to be agreed in advance.

Job Purpose:

To support the Examinations Officer in the efficient planning and management of school and public examinations.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- The post holder will be required to demonstrate a continual positive commitment to the Trust's policies
 including those relating to safeguarding children, health & safety, and equal opportunities. You will be
 committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of young people, a responsibility we expect all
 our staff to share
- Responsible for ensuring the exam venue JCQ regulations are adhered to throughout the exam season
- Responsible for ensuring the collation and distributing of all scrips for the internal exams, including printing electronic scripts
- Assist in the preparation of exam administration, including seating plans & student labels
- Assist in the preparation and clearing of exam venues in accordance with the JCQ regulations, including signage, seating plans, paper resources and specific equipment
- Assist the Examinations Officer with organising the correct resources are received for each exam venue, including the specific needs for students with access arrangements
- Assist in collating and dispatching GCSE scripts to the examination board
- Support the Examination Officer with student attendance and any arising issues during an exam





- Support Exam Invigilators in the smooth running of the exam venues, ensuring equipment for Invigilators is replenished when required
- Other duties and responsibilities, express and implied, which arise from the nature and character of the role and are commensurate with the grade of the post
- To comply with individual responsibilities, in accordance with the role, for health and safety in the workplace
